

Learning this week

This week we've been busy measuring in m, cm and mm as well as converting these measurements. In English, we began exploring the losing tale "David's watch", whilst paying attention to the features in the text as well as the language used. We have been also practicing fluency in reading; children worked very hard to read the text out loud in a way so that it was interesting for others to listen to.

In PE, we have continued with our HIIT, which proved to be extremely hard even for the teachers! Yet, despite the intense workout, the children showed determination, resilience and recognised the impact of the high intensity exercises. We have also discussed the importance of a balanced diet and how factors can influence our diet.



We have had an amazing World Book Day! All children, as well as teachers, came in dressed as different characters from a variety of books. It was great to see the

amount of effort children put into their costumes. In year 3, we focused on our class book- "*The Demon Dentist*" by D. Walliams . We ran a Reading Theatre, during the morning where children performed parts of the story whilst concentrating on intonation, volume and expression. Walliams, persuasive posters and imitated drawings of the illustrator, Quentin Blake.




Morrisons Donation
